Art4inc, Using Artistic Disciplines for Educational and Social Inclusion, is a two-year project (2017-2019) funded by the European Union's Erasmus+ Programme. It works with adult and community educators who are at the front-line of second-chance education and support their endeavours by providing essential in-service training to build their skills as educators.



Art4inc also provides a range of innovative embedded-learning and enquiry-based learning key competence resources that educators can use in their work with marginalized young adults.

What already happened from December...

Fourth transnational meeting: It took place in Virginia, Ireland, and its aim was to plan the implementation of the inservice training and the local learning festivals held in each partner country.



 Learner Manual: Learning content and resources were compiled in a document to build the skills, knowledge and competences required in the in-service training framework and translated into all partners languages.

Training activity: In-service training for front-line adult educators and migrant support



workers of 50 hours of learning. It included 3 days, 21 hour faceto-face instruction in Germany, focus on using artistic disciplines to engage adult migrants in lifelong learning, implementing the resources from the Educators Toolbox of Alternative Educational Resources and working in an on-line dynamic using the bespoke Art4inc e-learning portal.



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NEXT STEPS...

- E-learning portal: By the end of May the materials will be integrated on e-learning portal.
- Local Learning Festival: It will be held from May to July 2019 to present the new basic skill acquisition resources to, at least, 25 adult migrants in each country.
- National campaign event: At the close of the project, in September/October, to present the policy recommendations emerging from the experiences of project partners. Leading managers and policy makers from adult education are invited to debate about migrant integration.
- Final meeting: Our 5th and last meeting will be held in Schwerin, Germany, on October 15th to complete all project activity and financial reporting.
- Conference Symposium: A public event will be held on October 16th in Schwerin, Germany. It will attract an audience of at least 90 people drawn from adult and community education and migrant support agencies at management and practice levels. All partners will present an overview of the project achievements in their own countries.
